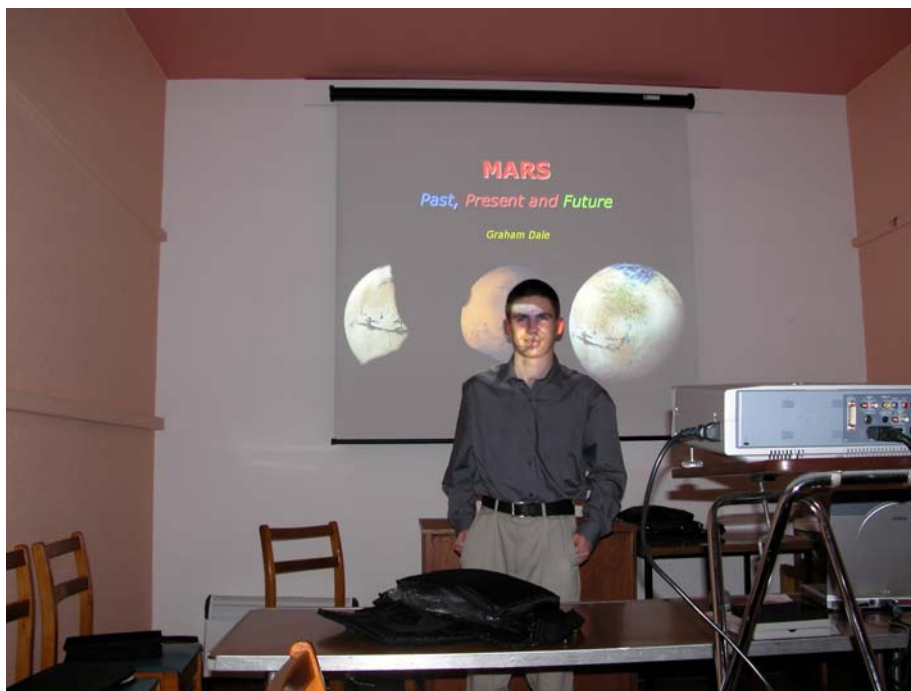
A.A.A Committee Member
